1999 FIDIC Conditions of Contract: Special Emphasis on DESIGN-BUILD Contracts

OVERVIEW

MC² MODERN Construction Consulting proudly presents the International FIDIC Contracts Training Seminar, which is organized in association with FIDIC.

Unlike other FIDIC training events, this is a ***three-day course*** on the 1999 FIDIC Conditions of Contract with special emphasis on Design-Build Contracting. For those who are involved in administration of FIDIC Contracts and in particular the ***DESIGN – BUILD*** or ***EPC*** type contracts, this is a not-to-be-missed event.

The 1999 FIDIC Contracts are being increasingly used in the international construction industry, particularly in Central and Eastern Europe, Middle East, Africa and the Caucasus. The aim of this training course is to help the participants gain confidence in working with these documents by having a good understanding of the risk allocation structure, roles, responsibilities and rights of the Parties under the 1999 FIDIC Contracts.

ABOUT THE COURSE and TOPICS COVERED

This 3-day training course will provide a thorough and up-to-date understanding of the main 1999 FIDIC construction forms of contract (**Red, Yellow and Silver**). The course begins by introducing FIDIC and the FIDIC suite of contracts, including latest developments. It will continue with a detailed consideration of the individual clauses of the Books, comparing and contrasting them with respect to certain key issues. A particular focus shall be given to the design-build forms and the key aspects of and differences between the EPC/Turnkey model of the **Silver Book** and the more traditional **Yellow Book**, such as contractor responsibility for design, fitness for purpose, errors in Employer's Requirements, and unforeseeable physical conditions. The course will cover explanations, illustrations and case studies for the use of the FIDIC Conditions of Contract. In addition, certain aspects of the MDB Harmonized Edition will be discussed.

SEMINAR TUTORS

The tutors are provided by MC² MODERN in collaboration with FIDIC. The training course is provided by two recognized professionals in the construction industry who possess extensive international experience.

Götz-Sebastian Hök

Dr. Hök is a senior partner of Dr. Hök, Stieglmeier & Kollegen and acting as arbitrator, adjudicator and legal counsel. He is an accredited FIDIC trainer and a FIDIC listed Adjudicator. He is a lecturer at Berlin University of applied science for construction contract management law and the co-author of the book "FIDIC for Practitioners".

Levent Irmak
