MODULE 1

Contract Management under the FIDIC Conditions of Contract

This course gives an introduction to the FIDIC Red Book, Yellow Book, and Silver Book. Its main focus lays on the explanation of all FIDIC procedures with regard to Time for Completion, Testing, Taking-Over, Payments and Claims. A further core aspect is to explain the legal wording against its background for further use in civil law jurisdictions.

MODULE S

FIDIC Subcontract

This course gives an introduction to the FIDIC Subcontract, which is fit for use with the FIDIC Red Book and the FIDIC MDB harmonised version. Its main focus lays on the proper use of the FIDIC Subcontract including a discussion of claims and disputes under the FIDIC Subcontract.

MODULE 2

Contract Claims and Disputes

This course goes through the claims' procedures and claims including the change clause. It covers CPM issues, delay analysis, causation issues and quantum problems. Contractor's views and Engineer's views will be discussed. Finally the course will show how a DAB works and explain typical situations in dispute preparation and resolution.

MODULE 3

Dispute Adjudication

This course will give a sophisticated view on Dispute Resolution practise under FIDIC Contracts. The course intends to explain dispute avoidance practises and problems as well as the appointment of DABs, preparation of referrals, conduct of hearings and decision making.

OVERVIEW

The training courses are designed to provide practical guidance to those who are involved in managing or administration of projects where use of FIDIC forms of contracts is required. The courses cover all management disciplines and procedures in the Pre-Contract phase of the project including the FIDIC Client Consultant Service Agreement and selection of the appropriate FIDIC form of contract. The courses also cover the post Contract award phase including all contract management disciplines and claim management issues.

By having a good understanding of the FIDIC risk allocation policy and the resulting responsibilities and rights of the Parties under a 1999 FIDIC Contracts, a more efficient management of the project may be achieved.
